FARMHOUSE INSPECTION

Mansfield Fire Department performed a safety inspection of the Farmhouse on 11/6/2023. Captain Garn evaluated smoke detector equipment and locations, exit and emergency lighting equipment, and other standard fire safety requirements throughout the building. New batteries have been replaced in all exit and emergency lights and will be tested on a regular basis.

This is another reminder to test smoke alarms regularly, change batteries and replace smoke alarm units every 10 years. Carbon monoxide detectors should also be tested regularly and replaced every 5 years.
