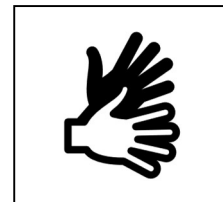

PORCH RAILING GUIDELINES (Policy will be posted on the website)

After several variance requests regarding porch railings, the Board thought it prudent to establish a policy to maintain uniformity in the community. Residents of the Tower Lakes Community wishing to install front porch and hand railing are to follow these guidelines

- 1. Railings and hand railings can be of wrought iron or aluminum materials.
- 2. Mountings are to be set in concrete for stability.
- 3. Black color is to be used.
- 4. Must be professionally installed.

A variance request is required and must be submitted to the Board for approval.
